Hello Dairy Goat Exhibitors!

Welcome to the 2018 REDGA Doe Show. In this flyer you will find all the information you need to get ready for a great time at the show! This is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Redwood Empire Dairy Goat Association Show!

This year we are back at the SONOMA-MARIN FAIRGROUNDS in Petaluma, CA. We will be setting up in the Swine and Sheep Barns. There is plenty of parking for trailers and trucks.

Youth are very important to the REDGA community and we appreciate their support and dedication to our show. We will once again have *Best Doe In Show owned by Youth* under two of the judges. Additionally, there will be special youth shirts, showmanship classes on Saturday morning, and a youth goat calling competition. A *new* fundraiser for our youth activities will serve as a fun group activity after the Saturday night dinner -- adults better brush up on their showmanship skills!

2018 will see the return of the Doeling Auction -- but this year is will be LIVE and take place on Saturday evening. Additionally, we will have our much loved raffles with many goat collector's items and exciting treasures to potentially bring home. Please feel free bring a donation or two for the raffle table AND buy lots of tickets! There are two raffles -- one each day. We usually have one or two "big" items (one will be an Arthur Cooney stanchion!) that will be drawn on Sunday. You can see a preview of some of the raffle items on the website.

**We will also have ONLINE ENTRIES as an option this year! So be sure to get them in early!**

### REDGA SHOW POLICIES

Pen Fee: The \$6 pen fee will cover the cost of the pen. FIRST STRAW IS NOT INCLUDED. You can order straw from one of the vendors on the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION page, or bring your own. Pens usually use  $\frac{1}{3}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a bale of straw per pen. NEW THIS YEAR: We are asking exhibitors to clean their pens before leaving, so we suggest you use as little straw as possible. When bedding your animals.

Dogs: No dogs will be allowed in the BARN or SHOW AREA. If you need to bring your dog, please respect the concerns of others and keep them penned or enclosed away from the barn. There is plenty of area for them to run and play outside. Please keep them on a leash and clean up after your animals. Thank you.

## Late Fees

**ADD \$2 for each doe per show OR ADD \$5 for each doe entered in all 4 shows.**  
Late fees effective: Mail-in, after Wednesday, May 16th/ Online, after Sunday, May 20th.

**Pen Fees**

\$6 per pen – Fee does not include first straw, and does not include clean-up after the show. Exhibitors are asked to clean their own pens this year. There will be wheelbarrows, rakes, and tarps available for cleaning. If you do not, please be prepared to pay a \$5 cleaning fee.

**In past years we have filled up very quickly! Please only request the MINIMUM amount of pens you think you will need.** These are large pens that can easily house 4 mature full size does.

**\*\* The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older, and this must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. The original registration certificate or stamped duplicate stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age, and must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. No copies of the registration certificate, the stamped duplicate, telegrams, faxes, or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.**

**\*\* NO ANIMAL will be allowed to remain on the grounds with any sign of contagious disease including but not limited to abscesses, sore mouth, ringworm and pink eye.**

# Youth

**1<sup>st</sup> place winners from the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior showmanship classes will have the opportunity to judge the Adult showmanship fundraiser Saturday night!**

## **Embedded Youth Show**

Under 2 judges (Murphy and Laney) there will be a selection of BEST Senior and Junior Does owned by Youth. No separate entry required. Youth must be under 20 years old on the day of the show. Enter birthdate on entry form. Youth must show their own animals unless they have multiple animals in the ring at the same time. Then the animal must be shown by another youth.

Ribbons will be awarded in the individual doe classes, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place youth doe from each breed age division will be brought back to compete for the champion and reserve champion of their breed. The champion youth doe from each breed will be brought back to compete for the Best Youth Doe in Show.

Free shirts will be given to the youth and should be worn while showing to help distinguish youth animals for the embedded youth show..

## **Youth Goat Calling**

This will take place Sunday, May 27<sup>th</sup> during the lunch break. Your doe will be held on one side of the show ring and you will call her from the other side. The pair to complete the task the fastest will win a prize.

Depending on the length of the show, this may have to change time.

Start training now!

## **Adult Showmanship (Youth Fundraiser)**

This year will be the first year of our adult showmanship fundraiser for the youth activities! All funds raised will go towards amazing youth awards and activities in the future. Please join us in supporting our youth exhibitors!

## **How it works (it's all in fun!):**

- Anyone is eligible 20 years of age and over (there will be prizes for participants).
- \$5 buy in (you can buy yourself in or buy other people in, ex. Someone you really want to compete)
- \$10 buy out (you can buy yourself out or buy other people out, ex. Someone you don't want to compete against).
- In order to buy in or out you must find **Janet Kracker**. There is a picture posted online. She is the only one that has the list and the ability change it.
- There will be no list posted, it will all be word of mouth on who is in and who is out.
- Youth showmanship winners will be the judges for this class.
- **The competition will follow the exhibitor dinner and sale on Saturday, May 26<sup>th</sup>!**
